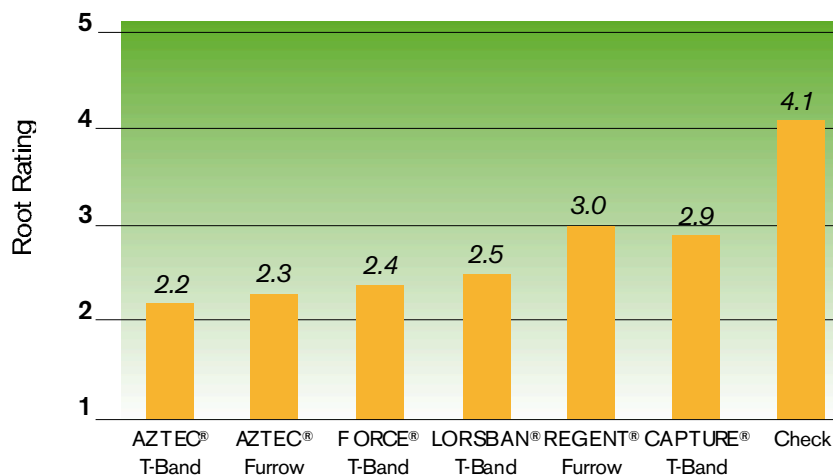

Consistent Performance



Summary of 21 university insecticide evaluations of corn rootworm conducted in IA, IL, IN, KY, NE, OH, and SD during 2002. The lowa 1 to 6 rooting scale was used or data were converted from the 0 to 3 node-injury scale.

AZTEC 4.67G Use Rates

Using a **T-Band Application**, apply AZTEC 4.7G at planting in a 4- to 5- inch band over the row behind the planter shoe and in front of the press wheel. Incorporation into the soil surface may also be accomplished with a drag chain or other suitable equipment.

For **In-Furrow** use, apply AZTEC 4.7G at planting directly into the seed furrow behind the planter shoe and in front of the press wheel.

AZTEC 4.7G should be applied at 3.0 oz. per 1000 feet of row. A maximum of 3.27 pounds of AZTEC 4.67G may be applied per acre per crop season.

AZTEC 4.67G must be applied with the SmartBox System. Be sure that the SmartBox meters are properly calibrated to apply the product accurately. Refer to the SmartBox equipment operator's manual for information on system operation and calibration.
